## Forms

- **Inside a <form></form> tag**
  - Three important attributes
    - × name=""
    - × method=""
    - × action=""
  - Name
    - × The name of the form
    - × Used in JavaScript, ASP.NET, and other languages
    - × ID should be the same

## Forms

- **Method**
  - Two options
  - "Get"
    - × Send information in URL
    - × Not widely used
    - × Cannot be used with <textarea>
  - "Post"
    - × Encodes the information in *form scope*
    - × Most often used

## Forms

- **Action**
  - The name of the page receiving the form
  - Can be relative or fully-qualified URL

## Input

- **Uses <input></input> tag**
  - Creates name/value pairs
  - Is the data sent to post page
- **Important attributes**
  - name=""
  - value=""
  - type=""

## Input

- **name=""**
  - What the data will be called
  - e.g. name="FirstName"
- **value=""**
  - What the data value will be
  - Not used in text fields (often)
  - e.g. value="Yes"

## Input

- **type=""**
  - Determines how the input will appear and act
- **Examples**
  - Text
  - Radio
  - Checkbox
  - Hidden

## Input – Other types

- **<textarea></textarea>**
  - Makes a large text box
  - cols="" and rows="" control size
- **<select></select>**
  - Creates a drop-down menu
  - Uses <option></option> to make items
- **type="submit"**
  - Creates a button
  - Sends the form for processing
